The National Register of Historic Places is the official federal list of districts, sites, buildings, structures, and objects significant in American history, architecture, archaeology, engineering, and culture. Listing in the National Register provides recognition of a property's historical significance and offers certain preservation incentives; it does not impose restrictions on the use, sale, or transfer of the property.
