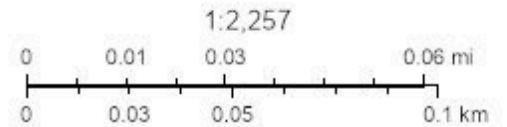

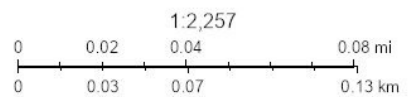

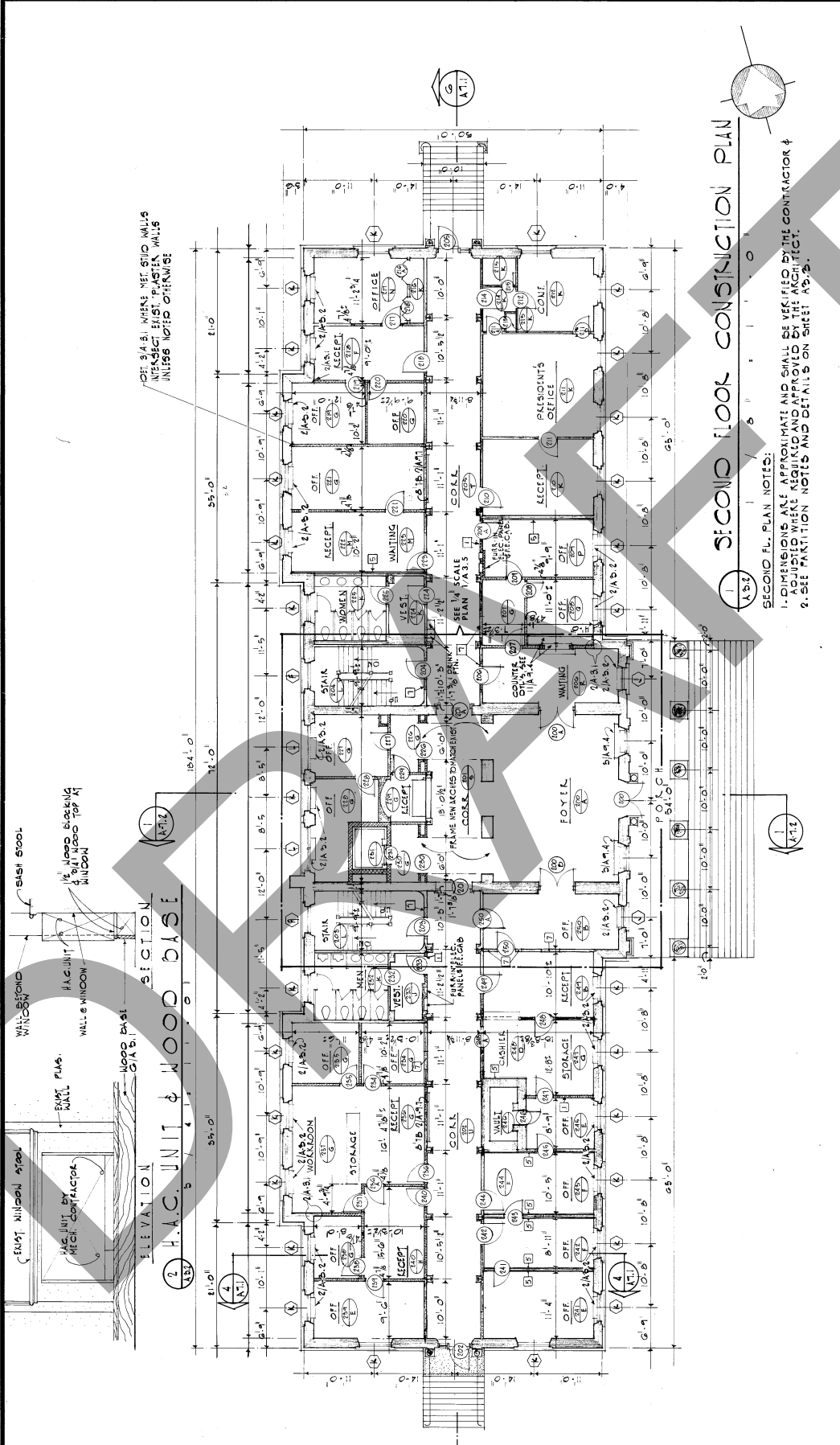

- Exist. marble floor & base; existing plaster walls and ceiling.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; patch existing plaster walls.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1 on north wall; and patch existing plaster walls and ceiling-wood base 6/A3.1; patch exist. plaster west and south walls; patch existing defective plaster on north and west walls.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; patch existing defective plaster on north wall; new gyp. wallbd on other walls; and new acoustic tile ceiling.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; new gyp. wallbd on north and south walls; patch defective existing plaster on other walls; and new acoustic tile ceiling.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; patch defective plaster on walls which are to remain; gyp. wallbd on new walls. See reflected ceiling plan for details.

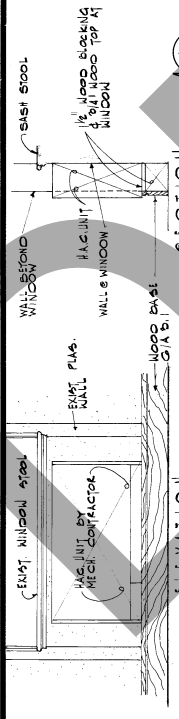

- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; new gyp. wallbd. on east and south walls; patch existing defective plaster on north and west walls.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; patch existing defective plaster on north wall; new gyp. wallbd on other walls; and new acoustic tile ceiling.
- New carpet floor; new wood base 6/A3.1; patch existing north and south walls; new gyp. wallbd on south and east walls, and existing plaster ceiling.
