01	Street View of front elevation looking south	Gives full view of main/front elevation with some understanding of setting
02	Street view - Oblique - looking southwest	provides information about scale/massing setting and ancillory structures (well)
03	close view of front elevation architectural details	Since the front is obscured by vegetation a close view can provide info about particular architectural details such as doors/windows/trim/etc
04	West elevation looking east	good clean view from appropriate distance; details still legible
05	east elevation looking west	good clean view from appropriate distance; details still legible
06	oblique view south/east elevation looking northwest	good clean view from appropriate distance; details still legible
07	realted structure possible tenant buidling looking east across field	provides understanding of relationship/setting
08	oblique view of north/west elevation (front/entrance) looking southeast	due to vegetation, oblique views and closeups where possible will be most helpful in understanding the structure
09	oblique view of west/south elevation looking northeast	
10	close view of south elevation architectural details	
11	north elevation looking south	
12	oblique view of north/east elevation looking southeast	Good view of east elevation not attainable at this time but an oblique that provides as much data as realistically possible is enough
13	view of two houses looking southwest from street	provides understanding of relationship/setting
